## DECEMBER 2008

### Reduced Light Shooting

**Prerequisite:** Student provides firearms & ammunition.

Consider that half of security work is performed in reduced light conditions. The majority of incidents in which officers use their handgun occur under darkened conditions and at close range. The worst time for officers being shot or assaulted are between 8:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. You must be able to identify the target, threat and background. Reduced light techniques must be based upon daylight training, dry firing practice and shooting under various low-light conditions. A heightened safety awareness is required. This course is a MUST for all security officers.
